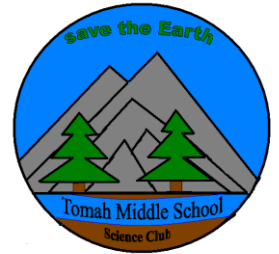




2018 Arbor Day Poster Contest
