Due to the recent outbreak of COVID-19, the City of Tomah will be altering the current garbage and recycling collection procedures.

Garbage

As of March 27, all **GARBAGE** shall be bagged and placed in **RECYCLING** totes. This action will allow the City of Tomah to continue providing waste collection and in the process, protect its employees.

The garbage schedule will not change. Continue to place your garbage, in the recycling tote, at its normal pickup location. Pickup times may vary; it is suggested to put totes out the night before.

If time allows, multiple pickups may occur. If you have excess garbage that does not fit in the tote, feel free to refill it after it has been emptied. If you are able to meet the garbage truck, please do so to get rid of all your garbage at once.

Recycling

At this time, recycling will no longer be picked up. Bagged recyclable items can be brought to the City Shop (515 E. Monowau St.) on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 7:00 AM -3:30 PM. After these hours you may place items in the back of the recycling truck parked outside. Please do not place items on the ground next to the truck. We ask that you consider your personal situation before using this method.

*If you are not able to transport your recycling it may be mixed with garbage during this time.

Please note that things can change on a day-to-day basis. We will keep our website as up to date as possible.
